A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and deliver the necessary instruments to transfer surplus rail and accessories to the Puget Sound Railroad Museum Society.

WHEREAS, King County purchased on February 15, 1977, approximately 21.97 miles of abandoned railroad right of way from the Milwaukee Road Railroad Company, and

WHEREAS, said purchase included 8,000 feet of 65 pound rail together with the accessory plates, angle bars, bolts, and spikes, and

WHEREAS, the County acquired said rail and accessories at no cost with the intention to donate them to the Puget Sound Railroad Museum Society, and

WHEREAS, the Society will use and keep said rail and accessories in the public interest as part of its permanent railroad display, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council does hereby determine that it is necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County to transfer without charge any or all of the above described rail and accessories to the Puget Sound Railroad Museum Society to be used for public display,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute and deliver the necessary instruments to transfer any or all (as may be required by the Society) of the surplus 6,000 feet of 65 pound rail together with the plates, angle bars, bolts, and spikes used as accessories thereto to the Puget Sound Railroad Museum Society without cost to the Society.
