A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit applications to the U.S. Economic Development Administration for funds under the Public Works Employment Act of 1977.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Employment Act of 1977 provides for the award of funds by the Economic Development Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce, to fund local government public works projects submitted under Title I of the Local Public Works Employment Act of 1976, and

WHEREAS the Public Works Employment Act of 1977 requires that an applicant jurisdiction submit as part of such applications its priority for each such project, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes that King County has several needed public works projects which will provide long term benefits to the citizens of King County as well as provide employment opportunities to the unemployed,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make applications for funds under the Public Works Employment Act of 1977 for projects contained on the Public Works project sheet attached hereto.
- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to make known to the U.S. Economic Development Administration of King County's project application priorities as enumerated on the Public Works project sheet attached hereto.
- 3. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
- 4. The King County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are necessary for the implementation of the projects.
