A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on the application for approval of the Proposed Plat of MORNING MEADOWS, designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 777-1 and adding a condition thereto.

WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, by report dated July 13, 1977, has recommended that the Proposed Plat of MORNING MEADOWS, designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 777-1, be approved subject to conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Council concludes that a condition should be added to the conditions of final plat approval to implement the

Council's intent that the concerns of the neighboring property owners regarding the acceptability of subject property for septic tank installation be given thorough study and careful consideration,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
The Proposed Plat of MORNING MEADOWS, designated Building and
Land Development Division File No. 777-1, is approved subject
to the conditions recommended by the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision
Examiner in his report dated July 13, 1977 with the added
condition as follows:

13. The Building and Land Development Division shall advise the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health of the Council's intention that the acceptability of subject property for the installation of septic tanks be given thorough study and careful consideration and further the Building and Land Development Division shall assure itself that such study and consideration has been accomplished.
