MOTION NO. C3161.

A MOTION requesting the Policy Development Commission to develop and recommend procedures relating to community plan committees and the community plan process.

WHEREAS, King County started the Middle or Community Planning Program in 1972 in order to provide short range (6-10 years) plans to guide capital and land development decisions; and

WHEREAS, based on a review of the community planning process completed by the Policy Development Commission in January of 1977, the County Council implemented recommendations that clarified the roles and responsibilities of the PDC, County Planning staff, and the County Council for the development of community plans; and

WHEREAS, based on the experience with recent Community Plans there is a need to further define the community planning process.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The Policy Development Commission (PDC) is hereby requested to review the County's experience with Community Plans now in development or recently completed and make recommendations where appropriate to further define the community planning process to ensure fairness and equity to all parties affected by a community plan.
- In its review, the PDC should seek the viewpoint of individuals who have been participating in the development of In particular, members of past community plan community plans. committees and representatives of the home building and real estate industries and other private development interests should be included in any committee formed to conduct this review.
- In its review, the PDC should give specific attention to the following: time schedule for development of community plans, general categories of individual and organizational representation on community plan committees, method of selection of community plan committee members, voting procedures by plan

32 33 committees, method of selection and replacement of plan committee members, establishment of interim policies guiding land development decisions during the community planning process, and the establishment of the issues to serve as the focus of the development of each community plan. However, any recommendations should allow for sufficient flexibility to reflect different conditions confronted by each community plan committee.

4. The PDC report should be completed and forwarded to the Executive and Council in sufficient time to allow for the recommendations to be utilized in the development of the community plans initiated in 1978.
