MOTION NO. 03161

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2 A MOTION requesting the Policy Development
3 Commission to develop and recommend pro-
4 cedures relating to community plan committees
5 and the community plan process.

6 WHEREAS, King County started the Middle or Community
7 Planning Program in 1972 in order to provide short range (6-10
8 years) plans to guide capital and land development decisions; and

9 WHEREAS, based on a review of the community planning process
10 completed by the Policy Development Commission in January of
11 1977, the County Council implemented recommendations that
12 clarified the roles and responsibilities of the PDC, County
13 Planning staff, and the County Council for the development of
14 community plans; and

15 WHEREAS, based on the experience with recent Community Plans
16 there is a need to further define the community planning process.

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 1. The Policy Development Commission (PDC) is hereby
19 requested to review the County's experience with Community Plans
20 now in development or recently completed and make recommendations
21 where appropriate to further define the community planning
22 process to ensure fairness and equity to all parties affected by
23 a community plan.

24 2. In its review, the PDC should seek the viewpoint of
25 individuals who have been participating in the development of
26 community plans. In particular, members of past community plan
27 committees and representatives of the home building and real
28 estate industries and other private development interests should
29 be included in any committee formed to conduct this review.

30 3. In its review, the PDC should give specific attention to
31 the following: time schedule for development of community plans,
32 general categories of individual and organizational representa-
33 tion on community plan committees, method of selection of
community plan committee members, voting procedures by plan

1 committees, method of selection and replacement of plan committee
2 members, establishment of interim policies guiding land develop-
3 ment decisions during the community planning process, and the
4 establishment of the issues to serve as the focus of the develop-
5 ment of each community plan. However, any recommendations should
6 allow for sufficient flexibility to reflect different conditions
7 confronted by each community plan committee.

8 4. The PDC report should be completed and forwarded to the
9 Executive and Council in sufficient time to allow for the
10 recommendations to be utilized in the development of the
11 community plans initiated in 1978.
