MOTION NO. C3200

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$3,800,000 to support the Work Training Program, Grant Files #742, #743, #744.

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the U.S. Department of Labor through the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support employment and training programs for low-income youth residing in King County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$3,800,000 to the U.S. Department of Labor through the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium to support the Work Training Program Out-of-School In-School and Summer components, on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such applications and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The U.S. Department of Labor is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
