A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$346,003 to support the Health Status of Survivors from Cardiac Arrest project, Grant File No. 728:2.

WHEREAS, the Department of Health, Education and Welfare
National Center for Health Services Research is empowered to make
grants to support research into health of survivors of cardiac
arrest, and

WHEREAS, the Health Status of Survivors of Cardiac Arrest Project will assist the County in meeting the needs of citizens of the County for emergency medical services,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$346,003 to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare National Center for Health Research for the Health Status of Survivors of Cardiac Arrest Project on behalf of King County.
- 2. At the time the Executive requests the appropriation of this grant, the Council requests that he supply the results of a review by the Division of Personnel of the salary range of the Co-Principal Investigator position.

The Council also requests the Executive to supply a detailed statement of duties for the positions of Co-Principal Investigator and Cardiologist Consultant.

- 3. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
- 4. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.

5. The Department of Health, Education and Welfare is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
