A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in an approximate amount of \$40,000 to support a County-unified weatherization program, and to authorize the executive to sign memorandums of agreement with local governments and private non-profit organizations to receive funds to support the County's unified weatherization program.

WHEREAS, the Federal Energy Administration and the Community Service

Administration are empowered to make grants to support weatherization

programs operated by local units of government, and

WHEREAS, the state of Washington, in its role as the Planning Agency for the weatherization funds, has determined that 37% of the funds coming into King County will serve residents in the King County outside of the city of Seattle, and

WHEREAS, the Executive intends to contract with the Housing Authority of King County to carry out a unified weatherization program in those areas of the County where the Housing Authority is authorized to operate, and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of King County is authorized to spend \$57,576 for CETA workers to carry out a unified weatherization program, and

WHEREAS, \$25,000 in joint Community Development Block Grant funds have been appropriated to carry out a unified weatherization program, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2988 authorized the Executive to contract with the Housing Authority to carry out a current expense-funded weatherization program for \$45,000, and

WHEREAS, Community Service Administration grants have been provided to the city of Seattle and to private non-profit organizations to carry out a weatherization program, and

WHEREAS, the city of Seattle and private non-profit organizations are willing to enter into agreements with the County to provide funds in support of the County's unified weatherization program, and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of King County to pursue and make available to homeowners of King County, all available funds for weatherization, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provisions of such services is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$40,000 to the Federal Energy Administration to support the County's unified weatherization program.
- The King County Exeuctive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required in order to carry out a unified weatherization program.
- 3. The King County Executive is authorized to enter into-memorandums of agreement with private/nonprofit organizations and the city of Seattle in order to receive funds to carry out a unified weatherization program.
- The Federal Energy Administration and the Community Service Administration is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
