WHEREAS, by Motion No. 2282, the County Council requested the County Executive to carry out certain studies to determine the most effective means to implement the Green River SCS Watershed and Corps of Engineers Flood Control Projects and to complete said studies by December 31, 1976; and

WHEREAS, by Motion No. 2312, the County Executive was authorized to request \$75,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds to carry out these studies and this request was approved by the Joint Policy Committee; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2646, the County Council appropriated the \$75,000 of Community Development Block Grant funds to the River Improvement Fund; and

WHEREAS, by Motion No. 2617, the Council authorized extension of the completion date of the studies to July 1, 1977; and

WHEREAS, by Motion No. 3097, the King County Executive was authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Green River Valley cities for the purpose of jointly developing a work program to guide the formulation of an interim policy and regulatory plan to govern new development and to mitigate the adverse impacts of existing and future flooding in the Lower Green River Watershed which are likely to occur before federal flood control projects are implemented; and

WHEREAS, Motion No. 3097 specified the work program be consistent with the development of the King County Subregional Land Use Plan and the work program of the Office of Agriculture, as specified in Ordinance 3064; and

WHEREAS, before entering into the Interlocal Agreement, the County Executive was requested by Motion No. 3097 to prepare and present to the Council a staffing plan with necessary budget
