A MOTION urging the government of the United States to continue its support to the Republic of China on the occasion of the forthcoming Double Tenth Chinese National Day.

WHEREAS, October 10, 1977 marks the 66th anniversary of the founding of the Republic of China by Dr. Sun Yat-sen, and

WHEREAS, the Republic of China, through the free enterprise system, has built one of the most sound, dynamic and successful economies in the Far East, and

WHEREAS, the Republic of China is of great strategic importance to the United States in the Far East and has always utilized its military power in the interests of the free world, and

WHEREAS, the people of the Republic of China, since its founding have been among the most trusted friends and allies of the people of the United States, and

WHEREAS, there has been a long-standing and beneficial bond between the people of our community and the people of the Republic of China,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council extends its best wishes to the people of the Republic of China on the occasion of the 66th anniversary of the Republic,

The government of the United States of America is hereby urged to continue its strong and long-lasting friendship, economic and diplomatic ties with the Republic of China.

A copy of this resolution shall be sent to President Jimmy Carter and Secretary of State Cyrus Vance of the United States of America and Prime Minister H.E. Chiang Chin-kuo of the Republic of China.
