WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1973, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support
King County Law and Justice Planning activities, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provision of such services is in the public interest, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$2,300 as a cash match in support of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$43,700, including \$2,300 as the State buy-in portion, to the State Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;
- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
- 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
