## MOTION NO. (3273

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Issaquah School District and to declare the County's intent on sewage service in the Water District No. 90 area.

WHEREAS, the Liberty High School was built by the Issaquah School District in 1974 and is located within the boundaries of the King County Newcastle Communities Plan area and Water District No. 90; and

WHEREAS, the Liberty High School was constructed without a system of sanitary sewers; and

WHEREAS, the Liberty High School is currently occupied for the school year 1977-78 and has installed a holding tank system for sewage disposal; and

WHEREAS, according to Water District No. 90 the sewer facility to serve the school is financially feasible only if federal and state funds are obtained for the capital expenses and new development occurs in the area to cover operating and maintenance expenses; and

WHEREAS, it is premature to commit to the sewer project before the Newcastle Communities Plan is completed; and \*

WHEREAS, the Newcastle Communities Plan is scheduled to begin in early 1978; and

WHEREAS, the Newcastle Communities Plan will include policies to guide the future growth of the Newcastle Community area including policies on the provisions of utilities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the King County Council that the timing and provision of sewers for the areas where communities plans are being developed should be addressed as part of the communities planning process.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. No commitment to build sewers in the Water District 90 area shall be made by the King County Council until the policies

of the Newcastle Communities Plan have been reviewed and adopted by the King County Council.

- 2. The Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Issaquah School District which agreement shall provide for the following:
- a. King County shall pay for the capital costs of upgrading the current system of sewage disposal at Liberty High School.
- b. King County shall assist the Issaquah School
  District in developing a long term method of sewage disposal if
  the improvements in 2a above are not determined to be adequate
  long term solutions.
- c. Issaquah School District shall be a participant in the Newcastle Communities planning process which is scheduled to commence in early 1978.
- d. The County shall consider changes in County regulations to enable the development and use of alternative methods of sewage disposal.
