1 MOTION NO. C3273

2 A MOTION authorizing the King County  
3 Executive to enter into an interlocal  
4 agreement with the Issaquah School  
5 District and to declare the County's  
6 intent on sewage service in the Water  
7 District No. 90 area.

8 WHEREAS, the Liberty High School was built by the Issaquah  
9 School District in 1974 and is located within the boundaries of  
10 the King County Newcastle Communities Plan area and Water  
11 District No. 90; and

12 WHEREAS, the Liberty High School was constructed without a  
13 system of sanitary sewers; and

14 WHEREAS, the Liberty High School is currently occupied for  
15 the school year 1977-78 and has installed a holding tank system  
16 for sewage disposal; and

17 WHEREAS, according to Water District No. 90 the sewer  
18 facility to serve the school is financially feasible only if  
19 federal and state funds are obtained for the capital expenses  
20 and new development occurs in the area to cover operating and  
21 maintenance expenses; and

22 WHEREAS, it is premature to commit to the sewer project  
23 before the Newcastle Communities Plan is completed; and

24 WHEREAS, the Newcastle Communities Plan is scheduled to  
25 begin in early 1978; and

26 WHEREAS, the Newcastle Communities Plan will include policies  
27 to guide the future growth of the Newcastle Community area  
28 including policies on the provisions of utilities; and

29 WHEREAS, it is the intention of the King County Council that  
30 the timing and provision of sewers for the areas where communities  
31 plans are being developed should be addressed as part of the  
32 communities planning process.

33 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. No commitment to build sewers in the Water District 90  
area shall be made by the King County Council until the policies

1 of the Newcastle Communities Plan have been reviewed and adopted  
2 by the King County Council.

3 2. The Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to  
4 enter into an interlocal agreement with the Issaquah School  
5 District which agreement shall provide for the following:

6 a. King County shall pay for the capital  
7 costs of upgrading the current system of sewage disposal at  
8 Liberty High School.

9 b. King County shall assist the Issaquah School  
10 District in developing a long term method of sewage disposal if  
11 the improvements in 2a above are not determined to be adequate  
12 long term solutions.

13 c. Issaquah School District shall be a participant  
14 in the Newcastle Communities planning process which is scheduled  
15 to commence in early 1978.

16 d. The County shall consider changes in County  
17 regulations to enable the development and use of alternative  
18 methods of sewage disposal.
