3 A MOTION urging the voters of Shoreline School  
4 District to support the 2.5 million dollar bond  
5 issue for capital improvements by voting yes on  
6 the proposition, November 8, 1977, General Election  
7 Day.

8 WHEREAS, the current capital budget fund for Shoreline  
9 School District is only 25,000 dollars, and

10 WHEREAS, to make necessary improvements to the existing  
11 educational facilities an additional 2.5 million dollars is  
12 needed, and

13 WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes that to  
14 implement necessary improvements it is necessary for the  
15 Shoreline School district to incur a general indebtedness by  
16 issuing its general obligation bonds in the principal amount  
17 of 2.5 million dollars, and

18 WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Washington require that  
19 incurring such indebtedness and issuing the resultant bonds is  
20 an issue which must be considered and ratified by the people  
21 of the Shoreline School District, and

22 WHEREAS, the Shoreline School Board by Resolution 446  
23 authorized a School Facilities Improvement Bond in the amount  
24 of 2.5 million dollars, passed unanimously September 22, 1977,  
25 authorizing the placing of the bond on the ballot of the  
26 General Election to be held November 8, 1977.

27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

28 The Council encourages the Shoreline School District Voters  
29 to support needed capital improvements in the Shoreline School  
30 system by voting affirmatively to the 2.5 million dollar general  
31 obligation bond issue November 8, 1977, General Election Day.
