MOTION NO. (3302

A MOTION remanding the Proposed Plat of Leisure Lakes, Building and Land Development File No. 1076-4, to the Zoning & Subdivision Examiner for reconsideration.

WHEREAS, the Office of the Zoning & Subdivision Examiner has forwarded a Report and Recommendation to the King County Council pertaining to the preliminary plat of LEISURE LAKES, Building and Land Development Division File No. 1076-4; and

WHEREAS, the subject preliminary plat is located in northeast King County in an area covered by the Bear Creek Middle Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 1018 in 1971; and

WHEREAS, Middle Plans and Community Plans are adopted as an augmentation and compilation to the King County Comprehensive Plan and intended to provide short range policies to guide the nature and timing of developments in areas which are undeveloped or in the process of developing and where there is not yet a commitment to urban services; and

WHEREAS, "G" General zoning is intended to regulate the use of land to prevent the premature establishment of urban land uses before proper and sufficient roads, utilities and governmental services are provided; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Leisure Lakes plat is located in a portion of the Bear Creek Middle Planning area which is undeveloped and where there are no urban services presently available and is zoned "G" General; and

WHEREAS, a November 3, 1977 written opinion of the Hearing Legal Counsel, pertaining to section 19.28.020 of the King County Code, states that "Preliminary plats which have not received approval by the King County Council should not be acted upon by the King County Council until they are accompanied by a letter of approval from the Health Department for the method of sewage disposal and water supply", and the proposed preliminary plat of Leisure Lakes has not received such a letter of approval at

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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The Council finds that Conclusion #2 of the September 29 Report of the Hearing Examiner on the preliminary plat of Leisure Lakes is in error as applied to "G" General zoned property and hereby remands the subject plat to the Hearing Examiner for further consideration.
- 2. In reconsidering said plat, the Hearing Examiner is requested to give weight to the policies guiding the nature and timing of development which are set forth in the Comprehensive Plan and the Bear Creek Middle Plan as well as the zoning for the subject property.
- 3. The applicant for the preliminary plat of Leisure

 Lakes is hereby requested to comply with the requirements for

 preliminary approval as set forth in the opinion of the Hearing

 Legal Counsel dated November 3, 1977.
