MOTION NO. 63319

A MOTION relating to the 1978 Housing and Community Development Block Grant, specifying projects for King County's Population Funds, and specifying projects for consideration for Countywide Needs Funds.

WHEREAS, Public Law 93-383, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, establishes a program of financial assistance to local governments for the development of viable urban communities through the provision of decent housing, a suitable living environment and expanded economic opportunities, primarily for persons of low and moderate income, and

WHEREAS, King County, twenty-six suburban cities, and the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe, as an urban county consortium, will receive \$5,704,000 of Housing and Community Development Block Grant funds for the 1978 - 79 program year, and

WHEREAS, King County will receive \$2,024,795 in Population Funds and will share in \$1,619,836 in Countywide Needs Funds, and

WHEREAS, King County has adopted its Plan for Community Development, 1978 - 1980, and

WHEREAS, the County Council has held public hearings to hear the views of citizens on housing and community development needs on October 18, 1977 and December 5, 1977;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The following projects in the funding categories and amounts specified are hereby adopted. The Executive is authorized to submit them to the Joint Policy Committee in accordance with the provisions of the Cooperation Agreement signed by King County and the other twenty-seven jurisdictions and in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance 3492.

The King County Council hereby commits \$28,000 in County Population Funds in the 1979 - 80 program year to CD 634-78 Highline Head Start Facility.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

The King County Council finds that the projects meet the requirements of federal law and regulations and that the projects give maximum feasible priority to activities which will benefit low and moderate income families, prevent or eliminate slum and blight, or meet urgent community development needs.
