A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into a contract with Northwest Cablevision, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Teleprompter Corporation, to maintain and operate a CATV system which includes the assigned franchises of other wholly-owned subsidiaries of the Teleprompter Corporation operating under Franchises 559, 551, and 562, as amended by King County Ordinances 522 and 3213.

WHEREAS, Teleprompter Corporation is desirous of consolidating the operations of its four separate wholly-owned subsidiaries operating in King County under one wholly-owned subsidiary to simplify its corporate structure, and

WHEREAS, Teleprompter Corporation has properly filled a request to have the franchises of these subsidiaries, Colorcable, Inc., Franchise No. 551, Crystal Cable, Inc., Franchise No. 599, and Seattle Cablevision, Inc., Franchise No. 562, as amended by King County Ordinances 522 and 3212, assigned to Northwest Cablevision, Inc., also a wholly-owned subsidiary of Teleprompter Corporation, and

WHEREAS, the request has been referred to the County

Executive for investigation of the feasibility thereof, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended approval of these assignments,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the assignment of Franchises 551, 599, and 562, as amended in King County Ordinances 522 and 3213, to Northwest Cablevision, Inc., and said franchises and amendments shall be binding on Northwest Cablevision, Inc., until termination date.

If, within thirty (30) days after the granting of this transfer, the applicant shall have failed to accept this assignment in writing, the herein granted transfer of Franchises 551,
