MOTION NO. 13356

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to coordinate the review of a surface water and water quality plan pursuant to RCW 36.94 as it specifically relates to the Juanita Creek Basin.

WHEREAS, Federal Law 92-500 mandated a nationwide effort to plan for "swimmable and fishable" waters wherever attainable by July 1, 1983 and Section 208 of this act authorizes and funds areawide waste treatment management planning to attain these goals.

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance 2525 has authorized the expenditure of grant money received from METRO, the designated local 208 Planning Agency, for a surface water and water quality plan for the Juanita Creek Basin as indicated on Attachment A, and

WHEREAS, extensive social, land use, natural environmental and hydrologic studies have generated technical information on the Juanita Creek Basin, and

WHEREAS, a draft plan has been prepared for surface water management in the Juanita Creek Basin, and

WHEREAS, citizen awareness activities have been conducted within the basin including the mailing of a draft planning report and questionnaire to all basin residents and land owners, the response to which has been favorable, and

WHEREAS, after an evaluation of potential funding sources to implement the plan, generating revenues pursuant to the County Services Act, RCW 36.94, was deemed the most appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized to coordinate the review of the surface water plan as required by RCW 36.94.

2. The County Executive is hereby authorized to form a review committee as required by RCW 36.94.050 to advise the County in the review of the proposed Juanita Creek Basin Surface Water Plan. As outlined in
