A MOTION designating February 24, 1978 as Student Leader Day in King County Government.

WHEREAS, Lake City Elks Lodge #1800 is sponsoring the annual Student Leader Day in King County Government, and

WHEREAS, each high school in King County has been requested to nominate one male and one female Student Leader from the Sophomore, Junior, and Senior classes, and

WHEREAS, these Student Leaders chosen by their school counselors and fellow students must be recognized as leaders in student affairs and must have a grade point in the upper half of class, and

WHEREAS, they will fill the post of County Executive, County Council seats, and department heads, in conjunction with the duly elected or appointed officials, and

WHEREAS, this program will be an outstanding experience in the mechanics of the Home Rule form of government such as we have in King County,

WHEREAS, this is the fifth annual observance of its kind to recognize the birthday of our first President, George Washington,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
