A MOTION denying the application for a Planned Unit Development petitioned by VILLA SOUTH, designated Building and Land Development File No. 222-77-P.

WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, by report dated September 1, 1977, has recommended that the application of VILLA SOUTH, a Planned Unit Development, designated Building and Land Development File No. 222-77-P, be approved subject to conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Examiner's recommendation has been appealed by the applicant and by property owners in the vicinity of subject property; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has reviewed the record and the written appeal arguments in this matter; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the addition of a mobile home park in this immediate vicinity, because of the single-family residential characteristics of the community and the impact of the already existent 400 unit mobile home park across the right-of-way, would constitute an unacceptable adverse impact to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner erred in concluding that approval of the

proposed Planned Unit Development, subject to conditions recommended in his report, would not be unreasonably detrimental to other properties or the public interest; NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The application for a Planned Unit Development petitioned by VILLA SOUTH, designated Building and Land Development File No. 222-77-P is denied.
