3 A MOTION of the King County Council,
4 fixing the date, time and place for a
5 public hearing on the final assessment
6 roll of Utility Local Improvement Dis-
7 trict No. 1 and on proposed Ordinance
8 No. 78-5.

9 WHEREAS, there has been prepared the final assessment
10 roll for Utility Local Improvement District No. 1 of King County
11 and such final assessment roll has been filed with the County
12 Council, and pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.94.250 it is
13 necessary to fix the date, time and place of public hearing on
14 such assessment roll and proposed Ordinance No. 78-7 approving
15 and confirming that roll, and to give notice of the filing of such
16 roll and such public hearing.

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 SECTION 1. A public hearing on the final assessment
19 roll of Utility Local Improvement District No. 1 and on proposed
20 Ordinance No. 78-5 approving and confirming that roll shall be
21 held before the County Council at 9:30 a.m. (PST) on
22 February 27, 1978, in the Council Chambers, King County
23 Courthouse, Seattle, Washington.

24 SECTION 2. The Clerk of the County Council is hereby
25 authorized and directed to cause to be published once a week for
26 two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in
27 Utility Local Improvement District No. 1, the first publication
28 to be at least fifteen days prior to the hearing date, a notice
29 stating that the roll is on file and open to inspection in the
30 office of the County Council and stating the time when the public
31 hearing before the County Council will be held on such assessment
32 roll, on the protests filed, and on Ordinance No. 78-5 approving
33 and confirming that roll, and advising the property owners
that protests must be filed with the Clerk of the County Council
against any assessments shown on the roll at or prior to the time

of such public hearing. Similar notices shall be mailed to the owners or reputed owners of the land in Utility Local Improvement District No. 1 as they appear on the books of the King County Comptroller, such notices to be mailed at least fifteen days before the hearing date.
