A MOTION directing the Justice Court Districting Committee to convene in accordance with RCW 3.38 to consider amendments to the District Court Plan.

WHEREAS, RCW 3.38 contains statutory procedures, requirements, and designation of representatives to serve on the Justice Court Districting Committee, and

WHEREAS, RCW 3.38 contains statutory provisions providing for amendment to the Justice Court District Plan which specifies the number of judges and courts in a county, and

WHEREAS, RCW 3.34 specifies the number of judges in King County and procedures to add additional judgeships because of population growth, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to convene the Justice Court Districting Committee to consider amendments to the Justice Court Districting Plan based on the potential need for an additional judgeship in the Federal Way Court, owing to population growth, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to consider an amendment to the Justice Court Districting Plan to re-examine the advisability of discontinuing the Mercer Island Justice Court District, scheduled to be eliminated in January, 1979.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: In accordance with RCW 3.38, the Council directs that the
