6 WHEREAS, RCW 3.38 contains statutory procedures,
7 requirements, and designation of representatives to serve on the
8 Justice Court Districting Committee, and

9 WHEREAS, RCW 3.38 contains statutory provisions providing
10 for amendment to the Justice Court District Plan which specifies
11 the number of judges and courts in a county, and

12 WHEREAS, RCW 3.34 specifies the number of judges in King
13 County and procedures to add additional judgeships because of
14 population growth, and

15 WHEREAS, there is a need to convene the Justice Court
16 Districting Committee to consider amendments to the Justice
17 Court Districting Plan based on the potential need for an
18 additional judgeship in the Federal Way Court, owing to
19 population growth, and

20 WHEREAS, there is a need to consider an amendment to the
21 Justice Court Districting Plan to re-examine the advisability of
22 discontinuing the Mercer Island Justice Court District, scheduled
23 to be eliminated in January, 1979.

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
