MOTION NO. C3388

A MOTION establishing Council policy with regard to the creation of a King County Women's Program.

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes the need to improve the status and well-being of women residing within King County, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes a responsibility to foster programs for the benefit of women throughout the County, and

WHEREAS, a King County Women's Program is in the process of formation,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Women's Program shall be established consistent with the following principles:

(a) Four ongoing agencies shall be designated as field representatives of the program, Bellevue Community College, Highline Community College, Green River Community College and Shoreline Community College;

(b) These agencies will be responsible for executing the program for the balance of the current fiscal year;

(c) A portion of the 1978 Special Revenue Sharing appropriation shall be provided to support the activities of the field representatives;

(d) Coordination of the King County Women's Program shall be directed by a centrally located employee of the County;

(e) An advisory group, representative of the diversity of women throughout King County, shall be established to assist in prioritizing needs and assist in evaluating the Women's Program.

(f) A work program shall accompany any proposed ordinance which specifies the organization and responsibilities of the Women's Program.

(g) The coordinator of the Women's Program and the advisory group shall prepare a report on the status of the women's program to be presented to the Council prior to the 1979 budget deliberations.

(h) The report will summarize the year's activities in
