MOTION NO. 63396

A MOTION relating to the strike by local unions against the King County Auto Dealers Association and urging the County Executive to intervene.

WHEREAS, the strike by five local unions against fifty-two members of the King County Auto Dealers Association has entered its tenth month, and

WHEREAS, any strike of that length is clearly injurious

(1) To auto dealers who see the businesses they have worked to establish falter in the face of reduced sales;

(2) To their striking employees who suffer great economic hardship because they have little or no income;

(3) To the motoring public which faces not only inconvenience, but actual damage because of improperly maintained motor vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the efforts of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service have been fully exhausted, and

WHEREAS, the County has an obligation to promote the welfare of all of its citizens;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Council hereby respectfully requests and urges the King County Executive to intervene and to use his good offices to resolve the strike of local unions against the King County Auto Dealers Association by calling the parties together immediately.

2. The King County Council hereby offers to provide whatever support and assistance the Executive may deem necessary.
