1 MOTION NO. 03401

2 A MOTION expressing Council approval of the
3 increases in rates and charges proposed by
4 Viacom Cablevision for its three wholly owned
5 subsidiaries operating in King County under
6 Franchise Nos. 546 (a/k/a No. 559), 561, 548,
7 549, 550, 569 and 614.

8 WHEREAS, the King County Council is authorized by ordinance
9 and franchise agreements to regulate rates and service relative
10 to cable television services, and

11 WHEREAS, United Community Antenna Systems, Inc., Franchise
12 No 546 (a/k/a No. 559), Community Telecable of Bellevue, Inc.,
13 Franchise No 561, and Vista Television Cable, Inc., Franchise Nos.
14 548, 549, 550, 569 and 614, wholly owned subsidiaries of Viacom
15 Cablevision, have since January 1, 1975, been charging subscribers
16 a monthly rate of \$8.50, and

17 WHEREAS, Viacom Cablevision has properly filed a request to
18 increase the monthly charge of these wholly owned subsidiaries
19 for all King County subscribers from \$8.50 to \$8.95 effective
20 January 1, 1978, and

21 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle Office of Cable Communications
22 has the authority delegated by the Seattle and King County Coun-
23 cils to approve the proposed rate increase for United Community
24 Antenna Systems, Inc., Community Telecable of Bellevue, Inc., and
25 Vista Television Cable, Inc., (d/b/a Viacom Cablevision) to \$8.95
26 per month, and

27 WHEREAS, these proposed rate increases are within the range
28 approved by the King County Council and the City of Seattle Hear-
29 ing Examiner, and

30 WHEREAS, the Office of Cable Communications has furnished
31 King County with the proper information and evidence to substan-
32 tiate the requested basic subscriber rate increase from \$8.50 to
33 \$8.95 per month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The monthly rate increases from \$8.50 to \$8.95 per month

1 proposed by Viacom Cablevision for its three wholly owned subsid-
2 iaries operating in King County under Franchise Nos. 546 (a/k/a
3 No. 559) 561, 548, 549, 550, 569 and 614 are found to be in the
4 public interest and are approved effective January 1, 1978.
