MOTION NO. 63402

A MOTION authorizing approval as of 24 March 1976 of an interagency agreement for use of state owned aquatic lands between the State of Washington and King County on the Snoqualmie River.

WHEREAS, King County requires the use of state-aquatic owned land for the construction of a pedestrian bridge across the Snoqualmie River as a part of the construction and access to a park by King County to be used by the public, and

WHEREAS, on 24 March 1976, the King County Executive, signed an interagency agreement for the use of state-owned aquatic land,

WHEREAS, RCW 39.39.030(2) requires the approval of the legislative body for an interagency agreement to be executed between the State of Washington and King County for the above purpose, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The interagency agreement between the State of Washington and King County dated 24 March 1976 for the use of state-owned aquatic lands for the construction of a public park and access to said park is hereby ratified and approved.
