MOTION NO. 03417

A MOTION authorizing expenditure of funds to provide inmates of the King County Jails with religious counseling services.

WHEREAS, prisoners of the King County Jails do not have free access to the resources of community religious institutions, and,

WHEREAS, such access could help mitigate the stress of their imprisonment and enhance the possibility of their rehabilitation,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized to compensate individuals who provide religious counseling services to inmates of the King County Jails at a rate not to exceed \$25.00 per day or the hourly equivalent thereof.

The individuals who provide the counseling shall be selected at the discretion of the Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services or his designee.

Every effort should be made to insure that any member of the inmate population may receive counseling relative to his personal religious faith, upon his or her request, at a time and frequency consistent with maintenance of order and security of jail operations.
