2 A MOTION establishing a Vashon Communities  
3 Plan Committee and establishing the responsi-  
4 bilities of the Community Plan Committee and  
5 the King County Planning Division in develop-  
6 ing a Vashon Communities Plan and approving  
7 the appointment of citizens to serve on the  
8 Vashon Community Plan Committee.

9 WHEREAS, a Community Plan for Vashon Island has previously  
10 been scheduled to commence in 1978, and

11 WHEREAS, the Vashon Island community has done considerable  
12 preliminary work to identify community concerns and priorities,  
13 and

14 WHEREAS, preliminary study has been initiated by the Planning  
15 Division on the Vashon Communities Plan, and

16 WHEREAS, a Communities Plan when adopted by the County  
17 Council represents the official development and capital improve-  
18 ment program policy for a community, and

19 WHEREAS, a Communities Plan provides the link between general  
20 county-wide policies, plans and programs and specific implementa-  
21 tion programs for a community, and

22 WHEREAS, a Communities Plan is intended to be utilized by  
23 other governmental agencies when making decisions concerning  
24 community development,

25 WHEREAS, the King County Executive and the Councilperson  
26 from District No. 7 have recommended ten members and two alter-  
27 nates each to the Vashon Communities Plan Committee per Motion  
28 No. 2946.

29 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

30 There is hereby established a twenty-one member Vashon  
31 Communities Plan Committee to be appointed as follows:

- 32 1. Ten (10) members and two (2) alternates to be appointed  
33 by the Councilperson from District No. 7;
2. Ten (10) members and two (2) alternates to be appointed  
by the County Executive and
3. A chairperson appointed by the Chairperson of the Policy

1 Development Commission.

2 4. Alternatives are to serve in the event a member is  
3 unable to complete his or her term, and additional alternates,  
4 if needed, are to be appointed by the original appointer of the  
5 member leaving the Committee, and approved by the Council.

6 5. All Committee members and alternates shall be subject  
7 to the disclosure provisions of K.C.C. 3.04.050.

8 6. Alternates shall assume committee membership based on  
9 the closest geographic proximity to the member resigning.

10 BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

11 The Vashon Communities Plan Committee shall:

12 1. Be responsible for developing the Vashon Community  
13 Involvement Process and executing the program with the assistance  
14 of the Community Involvement Coordinator assigned to the Community  
15 Plan by the Policy Development Commission.

16 2. Assist the Planning Division in developing proposed  
17 policies, programs and map alternatives for the community that  
18 are consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and other standards  
19 and official controls enacted by the County Council. Proposed  
20 policies, programs or map alternatives in the Community Plan  
21 that are not consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and other  
22 standards and official controls enacted by the County Council  
23 should be presented as recommended amendments to adopted County  
24 policies.

25 3. Recommend a Community Plan to the Council and Executive  
26 along with any alternatives the Committee or the Planning Division  
27 may wish to include,

28 BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

29 The Planning Division shall:

30 1. Prepare preliminary community profiles to include an  
31 inventory and analysis of the environment, population growth,  
32 land use, transportation, utilities, recreation, public facilities  
33 and services and compile existing plans and policies applicable  
to the area.

2. Prepare for review proposed policies, programs, and map alternatives.

3. Advise the Committee of possible impacts of proposed policies, programs and map alternatives and identify any inconsistent or unimplementable policies, programs and map alternatives under consideration.

4. Prepare preliminary and final Community Plan documents and Environmental Impact Statements.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The scope of the Vashon Communities Plan shall be concerned with areas of land use distribution and densities, transportation networks, open space and recreation facilities, sewer and water service areas, allocation of \$75,000 in 1978 Housing and Community Development Block Grant funds for Vashon, and related capital improvement programs planned for implementation in the next six to twelve years.

2. Said attached list of members of the Vashon Communities Plan Committee is approved as presented.

3. The schedule for completion of the Vashon Communities Plan will be as follows:

- a) June 30, 1978: Allocation of \$75,000 in 1978 Housing and Community Development Block Grant funds determined;
- b) September 14, 1978: Community Profiles completed and presented to the community;
- c) February 28, 1979: Preliminary Draft Plan completed and presented to the community;
- d) May 30, 1979: Final draft plan completed and transmitted to the Council.
