A MOTION adopting the 1979 King County Law and Justice Plan, and authorizing the County Executive to submit the Plan and formal grant applications for all 1979 King County projects contained therein to the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Division.

WHEREAS, the 1979 King County Law and Justice Plan and project funding recommended by the King County Law and Justice Planning Committee best meets the needs of King County and participating suburban city governments given the fiscal constraint of an estimated \$525,000 FY 1979 funds available to King County,
