

MOTION NO. 03158

A MOTION granting conditional approval to a reclassification from RS 7200 to RD 3600 for property of PAN-TERRA, INC. under Building and Land Development File No. 118-78-R.

WHEREAS, the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner by report dated February 21, 1978 recommended that the application for reclassification from RS 7200 to RM 2400 petitioned by PAN-TERRA, INC. under Building and Land Development File No. 118-78-R, be continued on call until the Council has adopted the Shoreline Community Plan and Area Zoning, and

WHEREAS, the Examiner's recommendation has been appealed by the applicant, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has reviewed the record and written and oral appeal arguments in this matter, and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that reclassification of the property to RD 3600, in lieu of RM 2400, subject to approval of a final planned unit development for no more than twelve (12) dwelling units, would conform to applicable Comprehensive Plan Policies and would not undermine the land use policies adopted by the Shoreline Community Plan Committee, and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the Examiner erred in concluding that this matter should be continued on call,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The property of PAN-TERRA, INC., under Building and Land Development File No. 118-78-R, shall be reclassified from RS 7200 to RD 3600, in lieu of RM 2400, subject to the following condition which is a prerequisite to Council approval of an ordinance
