A MOTION authorizing the sale of surplus Tax Title Property described as the South 80 ft. of the North 700 ft. of abandoned E & CVT Co's. R/W over the N 1/2 of the S 1/2 of Section 16, Township 25 North, Range 7 East, W.M. (T.L. 40)

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 2622 provides that the approval of the King County Council by motion is required prior to the Executives' disposing of County titled property, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Carnation has offered to purchase the hereinafter described parcel of Tax Title Property, and

WHEREAS, no King County Department or other Governmental Agency has expressed a need for retaining or acquiring title to the property, and

WHEREAS, the King County Executive has recommended that this parcel be declared surplus and sold to the Town of Carnation,
