MOTION NO.

A MOTION commending the involvement of Mr. Theodore Hagen, Principal of Decatur High School, the students of Decatur High School and the Office of School Security for the Federal Way School District, Mr. Ronald Sensenbach, for their roles leading to the apprehension of a suspect who allegedly assaulted a young woman on May 9, in the Federal Way area.

WHEREAS, on May 9, a fifteen year old Decatur student, a resident of Federal Way, was assaulted in a wooded area on her way to school, and

WHEREAS, upon initial investigation the Department of Public Safety made known to the Security Office, Mr. Ronald Sensenbach, of the Federal Way School District a general description of the suspect and the vehicle used by him in the commission of the crime, and

WHEREAS, the Security Office distributed the information to all schools in the Federal Way area, and

WHEREAS, on May 10, Mr. Theodore Hagen, the principal of Decatur High School, had distributed to all students of the school a description of the suspect and the vehicle used in the crime and a warning of specific things or situations to avoid to prevent occurrence of the same crime, and

WHEREAS, on May 11, Mr. Hagen, based on the responses of numerous students, informed the district's security office of the location of the suspect vehicle, and

WHEREAS, the identification of the suspect's vehicle and its location in such an expedient manner, following the commission of the crime, was as a direct result of the involvement of the students of Decatur High School, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hagen's passing of information to
Mr. Sensenbach, and his in turn to the Department of Public
Safety led to the arrest of a suspect May 11, two days after the
commission of the crime, and

WHEREAS, the involvement of these students and

administrators should be applauded as a fine example of how the community can directly assist law enforcement agencies in the solving of specific crimes, and

WHEREAS, in applauding the efforts of these individuals, it should be noted that the individual commitment of citizens to the welfare of their neighbors serves the interests of our justice system while making their community a safer place in which to live, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Council commends and applauds the students of Decatur High School, that school's principal Mr. Theodore Hagen,

Mr. Ronald Sensenbach of the Security Office of the Federal Way Schools, for their involvement in developing information that directly assisted the Department of Public Safety in arresting a suspect who has been charged with the crime of rape.
