A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$300,000 to support development of the Steel Lake Athletic Complex, Grant File No. 819:2.

WHEREAS, the Council of King County has approved a "Comprehensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the County which identifies a community park in the southwestern part of King County as a county priority, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act, state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County considers it in the best public interest to develop the Steel Lake Athletic Complex.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$300,000 to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, on behalf of King County;
- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the grantor;
- 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
- 4. The Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act;
- 5. Any funding assistance so received be used in the development of the Steel Lake Athletic Complex in the southwestern part of the County of King, Washington;
