MOTION NO. 3538

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to appoint the Office of Environmental Mediation of the University of Washington to hold talks between representatives of the Seattle International Raceway, Inc. and representatives of the neighboring community.

WHEREAS, the County wants to assist in establishing a mutually beneficial relationship between the Seattle International Raceway and the surrounding community, and

WHEREAS, it is apparent to the County that the Seattle International Raceway and the neighboring community are prepared to discuss certain mutual interests and concerns, and

WHEREAS, the Office of Environmental Mediation of the University of Washington is experienced in facilitating such discussions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive be authorized to appoint the Office of Environmental Mediation to use its good offices in assisting the community and the Seattle International Raceway in achieving such a mutually beneficial relationship.

2. That the Office of Environmental Mediation should report the results of the discussions by August 31, 1978.
