WHEREAS, the White House Conference on Balanced Growth and Economic Development stressed a local approach to developing goals for growth and development of our communities, and

WHEREAS, King County has applied to the Farmers Home Administration for a grant to support overall economic development planning in rural areas, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive needs the staff to fulfill the responsibility of developing a process for economic development planning throughout the County,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- work program that is coordinated with the Economic Development District and approved by the Economic Development, Employment and Energy Committee, is hereby authorized to submit an application on behalf of King County to the Economic Development Administration in the approximate amount of \$68,000 to fund the development of an economic development planning process;
