A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$249,460 to support improved pre-trial release programs for jail detainees and improved monitoring capabilities of the Subject-in-Process management information system.

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice, LEAA is providing funds to local governments to support projects which establish or improve pre-trial release programs that would relieve jail over-crowding, and
