WHEREAS, the Women's Program advisory Committee cannot act on funding requests until it has completed a needs assessment,

WHEREAS, the work of the Women's Association of Self Help will cease before completion of such needs assessment without emergency funding;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

provide emergency funding to the Women's Association of Self

Help to cover the expenses of office rent and telephone to a

Provided the contract between the County and Women's Association of Self Help states:

- 1) Any future funding by the County of Women's Association of Self Help shall be preceded by a positive recommendation from the King County Women's Program Advisory Committee.
- 2) The King County Women's Program shall have direct imput into the contract between the Women's Association of Self Help and the County.
- 3) The Women's Association of Self Help must investigate alternatives for ongoing funding, which must include possibilities of affilliation or merger with a community funded agency.
- 4) The Women's Association of Self Help must institute formal record keeping of all Board meetings, and all meetings in which the Board is represented. This includes minutes of the proceedings and attendance records.
