MOTION NO. 3705

1 A MOTION requesting emergency funding
2 for the Women's Association of Self Help.

3 WHEREAS, the King County Council is awaiting the recommen-
4 dations emanating from the work of the Women's Program Advisory
5 Committee,

6 WHEREAS, the Women's Program Advisory Committee, at its
7 meeting of August 21, has approved in concept the services
8 offered by the Women's Association of Self Help,

9 WHEREAS, the Women's Program advisory Committee cannot act
10 on funding requests until it has completed a needs assessment,

11 WHEREAS, the work of the Women's Association of Self Help
12 will cease before completion of such needs assessment without
13 emergency funding;

14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

15 The King County Council requests the County Executive
16 provide emergency funding to the Women's Association of Self
17 Help to cover the expenses of office rent and telephone to a
18 maximum of \$1,600.

19 Provided the contract between the County and Women's
20 Association of Self Help states:

21 1) Any future funding by the County of Women's Association
22 of Self Help shall be preceded by a positive recommendation from
23 the King County Women's Program Advisory Committee.

24 2) The King County Women's Program shall have direct input
25 into the contract between the Women's Association of Self Help
26 and the County.

27 3) The Women's Association of Self Help must investigate
28 alternatives for ongoing funding, which must include possibilities
29 of affiliation or merger with a community funded agency.

30 4) The Women's Association of Self Help must institute
31 formal record keeping of all Board meetings, and all meetings in
32 which the Board is represented. This includes minutes of the
33 proceedings and attendance records.

5) The Women's Association of Self Help must develop active working relationships with women's programs on the east-side, through instituting contacts with a minimum of three services which include Family and Child Service, Bellevue Community College Women's Center, and Eastside Mental Health.

6) The Women's Association of Self Help must establish a formal record system of service delivery.

7) The Women's Association of Self Help must provide documentation of these activities to the Women's Program on a monthly basis.
