MOTION NO. **3707**

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the Environmental Protection Agency for funds in the amount of \$34,957 to support Black Diamond Sewage Facilities Planning Study, County File No. 860:2.

WHEREAS, The Environmental Protection Agency is empowered by Public Law 92-500, Section 201, to make grant awards for the purposes of Water Quality Control, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Black Diamond has a need for a Facilities Planning Study and has agreed that King County will manage the study on their behalf, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide approximately \$4,928 as an in-kind share in support of this project, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, Department of Ecology, is expected to provide approximately \$7,391 as a cash contribution in support of this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$36,957 to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for the Black Diamond Sewage Facilities Planning Study on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the Project;

4. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
