MOTION NO. 3735

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to grant an easement in favor of the City of Bellevue over the plat of Mercer Slough Garden Tracts in District 6.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has installed a 30" storm drain line and appurtenances to accommodate surface water run-off on private property adjacent to certain land owned by King County known as Mercer Slough Garden Tracts, and

WHEREAS, a perpetual drainage maintenance easement across said Mercer Slough Garden Tracts in favor of the City of Bellevue has been applied for, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined it to be necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County that said easement be granted for the consideration of mutual benefits,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to sign and deliver the necessary easement, granting to the City of Bellevue, an easement of ingress and egress to and from County owned property situated in King County and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 10, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., described as follows:

The West 7 feet of the North 250 feet of the South 1/2 of Tract 32, Mercer Slough Garden Tracts and the North 7 feet of the South 90 feet of the East 80 feet of Tract 31 of said Mercer Slough Garden Tracts. Recorded in Vol. 8, Page 91, Records of King County, Washington.
