MOTION NO. **3739**

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for Federal Aid Urban Systems (FAUS) funds in the amount of \$19,000 to support FAUS Program Formulation for King County and the suburban cities and towns, hereafter referred to as the CONSORTIUM.

WHEREAS, the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1973 designated that locally elected officials shall have the authority to allocate the regionally apportioned FAUS funds according to locally established priorities, and

WHEREAS, the King Subregional Council's Subcommittee on Transportation (SUBTRAN) acting for the Puget Sound Council of Governments is the decision making body regarding said allocations for the King Subregion, and

WHEREAS, King County was assigned the responsibility of developing a County-wide program of projects to receive FAUS funding for all jurisdictions within King County except Seattle, Metro and Commuter Pool, and

WHEREAS, King County Department of Planning and Community Development, Planning Division has successfully completed the aforementioned FAUS Program Formulation Process for Fiscal Year 1979, and

WHEREAS, the King Subregional Council's Committees on Transportation has approved expenditure of FAUS-Transition Quarter Funds to support the County Planning Division efforts in this process through Fiscal Year 1981, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$3,884 as an in-kind contribution in support of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$19,000 to the Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
