WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Plan for 1978 identifies rehabilitation of the Clise Mansion as C.I.P. Project No. 030061, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$75,000 as a cash match in support of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 4. The Department of the Interior and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
