A MOTION requesting the County Executive to submit an appropriation ordinance to the County Council for acquisition of the former Bulk Plant and Dock owned by Chevron U.S.A., Inc. and located on Vashon Island.

WHEREAS, in the past, King County has sought to acquire the former Bulk Plant and Dock owned by Chevron U.S.A., Inc., and

WHEREAS, Chevron U.S.A. has now communicated with King County with an offer to sell the above property for its King County appraised value, and

WHEREAS, private parties have made offers for the subject property, and

WHEREAS, public benefit from recreational use of the subject property justifies its acquisition,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Executive is hereby requested to immediately contact Chevron U.S.A. and initiate negotiations for acquisition of the subject property.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED that the King County Executive is hereby requested to prepare and submit to the Council forthwith an ordinance appropriating funds for the acquisition of the former Bulk Plant and Dock by Chevron U.S.A., Inc.
