WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, by report dated June 15, 1978, has recommended that the property subject to the appeal of ALASKA AIRLINES, designated Building and Land Development File No. 242-78-R, remain classified MP, and that relief from the impact of the setback requirements of that zone classification be sought by application for variance, and
