MOTION NO. (3787

A MOTION replacing the East and West Side Green River Watershed Projects Advisory Committee with the Green River Basin Executive Committee (BEC) and designation Councilman—Gary Grant as the King County Council representative to the BEC, composed of elected representatives of sponsors of the Green River Basin Program.

WHEREAS, King County and the cities of Auburn, Kent, Renton and Tukwila have adopted an intergovernmental agreement establishing the Green River Basin Program as the comprehensive surface water management plan for the Green River basin; and

WHEREAS, the Green River Basin Program requires that a policy advisory committee of elected officials be established for the purpose of providing a management framework to carry out the major elements of the basin program; and

WHEREAS, a policy advisory committee known as the Green River Basin Executive Committee has been established and includes elected representatives from King County, Auburn, Kent, Renton, Tukwila, King County Conservation District and the Green River Flood Control Zone District; and

WHEREAS, the Green River Flood Control Zone District is represented on the Green River Basin Executive Committee by the King County Council which is established as the governing body of the zone district; and

WHEREAS, the East and West Side Green River Watershed Projects

Advisory Committee was originally established as a steering committee of
local sponsors to provide information to the Soil Conservation Service
on the watershed projects; and

WHEREAS, to avoid redundancy and confusion there is a need to formally replace the East and West Side Green River Watershed Projects Advisory Committee with the Green River Basin Executive Committee and to appoint representatives thereto.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

- 1. The Green River Basin Executive Committee hereby supercedes and replaces the East and West Side Green River Watershed Projects Advisory Committee. Further, the Green River Basin Executive Committee shall be responsible for and have authority to collectively coordinate all local sponsor actions necessary to carry out the elements of the Green River Basin Program.
- Councilman Gary Grant is hereby designated as the King County Council representative to the Green River Basin Executive Committee representing the Green River Flood Control Zone District. Councilman Grant will report to the Council, governing board of the flood control zone district, on all matters pertaining to the Green River Basin Program which require Council action.
