3 A MOTION replacing the East and West Side Green River
4 Watershed Projects Advisory Committee with the Green River
5 Basin Executive Committee (BEC) and designation Councilman
6 Gary Grant as the King County Council representative to
7 the BEC, composed of elected representatives of sponsors
8 of the Green River Basin Program.

9 WHEREAS, King County and the cities of Auburn, Kent, Renton and
10 Tukwila have adopted an intergovernmental agreement establishing the
11 Green River Basin Program as the comprehensive surface water management
12 plan for the Green River basin; and

13 WHEREAS, the Green River Basin Program requires that a policy
14 advisory committee of elected officials be established for the purpose
15 of providing a management framework to carry out the major elements of
16 the basin program; and

17 WHEREAS, a policy advisory committee known as the Green River Basin
18 Executive Committee has been established and includes elected representatives
19 from King County, Auburn, Kent, Renton, Tukwila, King County Conservation
20 District and the Green River Flood Control Zone District; and

22 WHEREAS, the Green River Flood Control Zone District is represented
23 on the Green River Basin Executive Committee by the King County Council
24 which is established as the governing body of the zone district; and

26 WHEREAS, the East and West Side Green River Watershed Projects
27 Advisory Committee was originally established as a steering committee of
28 local sponsors to provide information to the Soil Conservation Service
29 on the watershed projects; and

1 WHEREAS, to avoid redundancy and confusion there is a need to
2 formally replace the East and West Side Green River Watershed Projects
3 Advisory Committee with the Green River Basin Executive Committee and to
4 appoint representatives thereto.

6 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7
8 1. The Green River Basin Executive Committee hereby supercedes
9 and replaces the East and West Side Green River Watershed
10 Projects Advisory Committee. Further, the Green River Basin
11 Executive Committee shall be responsible for and have authority
12 to collectively coordinate all local sponsor actions necessary
13 to carry out the elements of the Green River Basin Program.

15 2. Councilman Gary Grant is hereby designated as the King County
16 Council representative to the Green River Basin Executive
17 Committee representing the Green River Flood Control Zone
18 District. Councilman Grant will report to the Council, governing
19 board of the flood control zone district, on all matters
20 pertaining to the Green River Basin Program which require
21 Council action.
