MOTION NO. 03797

A MOTION of intention to continue Probation Subsidy Program during 1979.

WHEREAS, Chapter 307, Laws of 1977, 1st Ex. Sess., amending RCW 13.06.050, provides that a special supervision program for Juvenile Court probation services would be reimbursed from State funds, and

WHEREAS, the payment of said reimbursement is regulated by the Department of Social and Health Services rules and regulations, and

WHEREAS, said laws and regulations require participating counties to notify the State of their intent to continue said program as a preliminary application for funding reimbursement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That it is the expressed intent of King County to continue the Probation Subsidy Program for the fiscal year 1979 and that the budget document entitled, "King County Department of Youth Services, Special Supervision Program Budget for January 1 - June 30, 1979," which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof shall be submitted to the Director of the State Department of Social and Health Services to insure continued State participation in said program.
