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A MOTION approving and authorizing the King County Executive to forward the attached King County Department of Public Works & Transportation proposed six-year Road Program and Bridge Deficiency Report (1979-1984) to the Washington State Department of Transportation and County Road Administration Board.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington through the Legislative process has set forth specific requirements upon the County Road Engineers per R.C.W. 36.81.121 to prepare and present to their respective Legislative bodies for adoption a six-year Road Program Plan, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Legislature in 1965 established a body known as the County Road Administration Board which has established uniform administrative standards of good practice throughout the State of Washington per W.A.C. 136-14 and W.A.C. 136-20, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with R.C.W. 36.81.121, the attached King County Department of Public Works & Transportation proposed six year Road Program and Bridge Deficiency Report (1979-1984) was presented to the Council of King County during a public hearing held on Actualy 30 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The attached King County Department of Public Works and

Transportation proposed six-year Road Plan and Bridge Deficiency

Report (1979-1984) is hereby approved and the King County Executive is authorized to forward the report to the Washington State

Department of Transportation and the County Road Administration

Board, provided that, the following changes be included in the six-year Road Plan:

Page 4, Item 1 - 195th Avenue Southeast. Schedules engineering, right-of-way and construction phases are rescheduled for 1979, 1980 and 1981 respectively.

2. <u>Page 4, Item 6 - Southwest 116th Street, Ambaum Boulevard</u>
Southwest to 30th Avenue Southwest.

Cost Estimate: Local \$232,000 FAM 294,000

TOTAL \$526,000

Local costs have been added because the project has been extended westerly from 26th Avenue Southwest to 30th Avenue Southwest to correct safety problems associated with Shorewood Elementary School. This portion is not eligible for federal funding. Updated cost estimate accounts for an increase in federal fund portion. The 1978 Transportation Improvement Program allocating the necessary federal funds has been amended by the Puget Sound Council of Governments.

- 3. <u>Page 5, Item 12 Northeast 181st Street</u>.

 Scheduled engineering phase is rescheduled for 1979.
- 4. Page 6, Item 8 East Lake Sammamish Boulevard.

 Limits should be redefined to read Southeast 56th South

 Street to S.R. 202; the description should read shoulder improvements; the length should read 9.50 miles; remarks should read improve shoulder for non-motorized use.
- 5. Page 8, Item 6 Des Moines Way South & South 200th Street.

Revise schedule to read: 1979 1-engineering; 1980 3-construction. The 1979 Transportation Improvement

Program has been amended by the Puget Sound Council of
Governments to authorize the FAM expenditure.

6. Page 8, Item 9 - 132nd Avenue Southeast and Southeast 240th - Signal.

Scheduled engineering and construction phases are resche-Page 2

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duled for 1979 and 1980 respectively.

- 7. Page 10, Item 2 South 102nd Street.

 This project should be deleted. A maintenance project has adequately corrected the deficiency.
- 8. Page 10, Item 3 118th Avenue Southeast.

 This project should be delayed one year; 1980 1-engineering; 1981 3-construction.
- 9. Page 10, Item 6 Southwest 127th Street.

 This project should be deleted. A maintenance project has adequately corrected the deficiency.
- 10. Page 11, Item 15 20th Avenue South.

 Scheduled engineering, right-of-way and construction phases are rescheduled to engineering and right-of-way phases for 1979 and right-of-way (continued) and construction phases for 1980.

Added Projects

- 11. Longacres Parkway Southwest (Phase IV) .6 mi.

 South 140th Street to Southwest Sunset Boulevard. Grading, drainage, paving, curbs, sidewalks, illumination, channelization, landscaping, 56 roadway. To be constructed in coordination with the city of Renton. The City of Renton will complete Phases I, II & III.
