MOTION NO. 3910

A MOTION relating to the amended 1978 - 1979 Housing Assistance Plan, and adopting a second amendment thereto.

WHEREAS, the County annually adopts a Housing Assistance Plan on behalf of itself and its Urban Consortium members who participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has recently approved a proposed revision of the 1978 - 1979 Housing Assistance Plan adopted by the Council in Motion No. 3380 and amended by Motion No. 3546; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development will have more housing units available to be allocated to King County than were originally anticipated; and

WHEREAS, a revision before December 22, 1978, would allow the County to more effectively utilize available federal housing assistance, particularly by increasing the number of assisted elderly units possible;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The attached amendment to the 1978 - 1979 Housing Assistance Plan, as amended, is hereby adopted.
